

USING EBOOKS & AUDIOBOOKS ON YOUR Smartphone or Tablet

Download eBooks and Audiobooks and stream videos on your mobile phone or tablet including:

- iPad, iPhone, iPod Touch
- Android phone or tablet



Required application & authorization

1. Begin by installing the **OverDrive** mobile app from your app store.
2. You will be prompted to create an OverDrive account. If you are under 13, select "I am under 13 years old" instead. The OverDrive account will allow you to synchronize your reading progress, bookmarks, and searches across multiple devices.
3. Once the OverDrive account has been registered, select **Add Library** from the top of the menu and search for downloadLibrary. Add it as your favourite library by selecting the star.

Searching for & downloading titles

1. Search for titles in the following ways: enter title / keywords in the search box; browse by format; browse by subject.
2. If you search for titles, your results will contain all formats – eBooks, audiobooks and video. You can filter by format using the **Filter search by** icon.
3. This is also where you can restrict your search results to titles currently available by clicking the **Available Now** box.

4. When you have found a title you want, tap the cover and select **Borrow**. If the title is already checked out by someone else, you may **Place a Hold**.
5. You will be asked to sign in. Select your Public Library. Sign in by entering your library card number (no spaces) and your PIN (last 4 digits of your phone number). The title is automatically checked out with the default loan period.
6. Download the book by tapping the **Download** button beside the item. The book automatically opens in the app. Use the menu icon to access the app bookshelf and begin reading.
7. Use **OverDrive Read** to read [eBooks](#) in the browser. Click once on **Read** and start reading. [Bookmark the link to access it again without logging into your account. You don't even need to be online – the book is cached on your computer.](#)

Returning books early

eBooks, audiobooks and video expire on their due date, but you can return them early, allowing someone else to enjoy the items sooner.

- While looking at the list of books out in the app, tap the cover you wish to return for 2 seconds. A menu appears. Select **Return**.

Notes

- eBooks and audiobooks can be downloaded for 7, 14 or 21 days. Adjust your default under **Settings**. Video has a 3, 5, or 7 day loan period.
- eBooks and audiobooks can be renewed 3 days prior to being due if no one is on the wait list.
- The Kindle Fire is currently the only Kindle compatible in Canada.
- A limit of 15 items total can be out at one time.
- In **App Settings**, you can turn off the automatic sending of anonymous usage data.
- You can view your digital account information, place holds and make renewals also using your BiblioCommons account.
